

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 3, 2009**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, June 3, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. Due to the lack of air conditioning Chairman Jordan moved the location of the meeting from the Commissioners' Room to the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Jordan, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Twine were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell, and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order. A prayer was led by Rev. Gene Asbill. Chairman Jordan led the pledge of allegiance.

**Approval of Agenda**

Colleen Turner, DSS Director, requested to be on today's agenda to present some information she has just received.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the agenda as presented with the addition of Colleen Turner. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the May 6, 2009 Meeting Minutes as written. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to approve the May 18, 2009 Meeting Minutes as written. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Department Reports**

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 85-95, deleting Budget Amendment 89.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 85-88, delete 89, approve 90-93, hold 93-A, and approve 94-95 as presented. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, stated the County currently had a 93.34% tax collection rate. Letters have been sent to citizens with delinquent taxes requesting them to pay their taxes. A list is being compiled by Travis Ellis for collection proceedings. Mrs. McGinnis stated she has received a memo from Smith/Buckland, Inc. Pitt Godwin, County Attorney, is preparing a statement of response.

Mrs. McGinnis stated the date has been extended for the Board of Equalization and Review until July 24, 2009.

Commissioner Nickens stated he has spoken to Mr. Chappell regarding the collection of solid waste fees for citizens with private wells. Mr. Godwin has been asked to review the solid waste fee collection policy. Chairman Jordan stated he was concerned with accountability.

Commissioner Twine made a motion for Mr. Chappell to amend the Solid Waste Ordinance to address the concern of being able to collect solid waste fees as personal property tax and/or real property tax.

Mr. Godwin commented currently there is no ordinance to cover the Smith/Buckland memo. He will be able to give the Board a written report at the next meeting.

The Board reconvened after a brief recess.

**Old Business**

Chairman Jordan stated Shirley Grimes has been attending meetings in Raleigh as an advocate for the senior citizens of Gates County. The current issue pertains to Mrs. Grimes attendance earlier this year. After Mrs. Grimes had paid a \$20 hotel deposit, Mr. Chappell explained the Commissioners had enacted travel restrictions. Mrs. Grimes attended her meeting and presented the \$137 hotel invoice for reimbursement.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to reimburse Mrs. Grimes the \$137 hotel expense for her meeting. Chairman Jordan seconded the motion. Chairman Jordan and Commissioner Nickens voted for the motion.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to reimburse Mrs. Grimes the \$20 hotel deposit expense she had incurred prior to the travel restrictions. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**New Business**

Brad Gardner, Perquimans, Chowan and Gates (PCG) Solid Waste Manager, presented a 3-year update on the 10-year Management Plan. There are currently 13 convenience sites in the three (3) counties.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to adopt a Resolution to Approve the PCG 10-year Solid Waste Management Plan Update. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented the Annual Participation Agreement to join the NC Association of County Commissioners Health Insurance Trust d.b.a. NCACC Group Benefits Pool. He explained the premiums have decreased but the benefits remain the same.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to approve the Annual Participation Agreement to join the NC Association of County Commissioners Health Insurance Trust. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Colleen Turner, DSS Director, presented an up-date regarding a proposal to close the state child support offices and transfer the responsibility to the local level. If the local level assumes this responsibility, staff, budget and attorney fees will need to be in place by 2011. DSS would not have a problem with this responsibility but she wanted to make the Board aware of the financial impact.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion not to support the closing of the state child support offices and to contact our legislatures. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell stated he would draft a Resolution.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to adopt a Resolution to Oppose the Transfer of Child Support Enforcement Responsibilities from the State to Local Level. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION  
TO OPPOSE THE TRANSFER OF  
CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES  
FROM THE STATE TO LOCAL LEVEL**

**Whereas**, it has been brought to the attention of the Gates County Board of Commissioners that the State of North Carolina is attempting to transfer the administrative and financial responsibilities pertaining to child support enforcement from their twenty-eight offices onto the counties that are currently being served by these offices; and

**Whereas**, the state of North Carolina is attempting to eliminate their financial deficit through the transfer of responsibilities from the State to the local level; and

**Whereas**, the local level, as being a political subunit of the State, is experiencing their own share of financial difficulties; and

**Whereas**, the local level stands opposed to unfunded mandates from the State level; and

**Whereas**, this change will place an undue and unanticipated financial strain on the local level

**We**, The Board of Commissioners of Gates County, on this day June 3, 2009, do hereby announce our opposition to this change in policy. Additionally, we implore our State representatives to remove this albatross from local government.

There being no further business Commissioner Twine made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
