

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 3, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, February 3, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell, and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order. A prayer was led by Rev. Tracy Clayton. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the following amendments needed to be made to the Agenda: Rube Blanchard, Finance Officer, Gates County Board of Education would like to be added; Mr. Chappell will present the Finance Officer and Tax Officer Reports; approve the Chairman to sign a letter on behalf of the Board and Darlene Harrell, Albemarle Commission, has canceled.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the amended Agenda. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the January 6 and January 20 meeting minutes as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Department Reports

Rube Blanchard, Finance Officer, Gates County Board of Education, requested Board approval to move \$438,000 from the Capital Outlay Reserve Fund Balance back into the Capital Outlay Fund to help cover the expense for the Gates County High School Re-Roofing Project.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the transfer of funds from Reserve Fund Balance back into Capital Outlay Fund. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

In the Finance Officers absence, Mr. Chappell presented Budget Amendments 44 – 51.

Mr. Jernigan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 44, 48-51. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

In the Tax Collectors absence, Mr. Chappell stated the tax collection rate was 84.47%.

Old Business

Chairman Twine discussed the appointment of an at large member to the Albemarle Commission Board. Sandra Nickens, Gatesville, stated she would be interested in serving. The names of interested citizens who wish to serve will continue to be accepted and an appointment will be made at the March 3 meeting.

Commissioner Askew discussed the center fire rifle issue. At this time he felt more research needed to be conducted before the Commissioners made a decision.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, stated he felt the Wildlife Resources Commission had the authority to make a ruling on center fire rifles instead of putting the burden on the Commissioners.

Commissioner Jernigan requested the attorney research this concern. He also stated his original concern was to concentrate on the game lands west of highway 13, not county-wide.

Mr. Chappell discussed Child Support Enforcement. A consortium, formed of potentially eleven (11) counties, has decided it would be most cost efficient to contract with Young-Williams Company. Mr. Chappell plans to return to the next Board meeting with a negotiated contract for consideration.

Mr. Chappell presented a Resolution Opposing the Transfer of the Secondary Road Program to Counties.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to adopt the Resolution Opposing Transfer of Secondary Road Program to Counties. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION
TO
OPPOSE TRANSFER OF SECONDARY ROAD PROGRAM TO COUNTIES**

WHEREAS, Gates County opposes (1) the transfer of Secondary Road Program funding to the Primary Road Program or any other program that will reduce funding for secondary road construction, improvement and maintenance, (2) any efforts by the General Assembly or NCDOT to shift any transportation costs formerly paid by the State to the counties, and (3) any efforts by the General Assembly to appropriate local revenues whether property tax, sales tax or any other local revenue for State transportation programs or any other State programs; and

WHEREAS, legislation has now been introduced (Senate Bill 758) that would transfer responsibility for the maintenance of secondary roads from the State to counties beginning in 2011; and

WHEREAS, according to statistics compiled by the North Carolina Department of Transportation in 2008, there are 277 miles of secondary roads in Gates County; and

WHEREAS, without the continuation of existing State revenue streams to pay for road upkeep and construction, Gates County would be forced to raise its property tax rate 10 cents in order to keep up the current level of funding (\$810,000) needed to maintain our existing secondary roads; and

WHEREAS, Gates County does not have the equipment or capital to take on this massive additional responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gates County Board of Commissioners:

1. Strongly oppose SB 758, which, if ratified would transfer responsibility for and maintenance of secondary roads from the State to the counties.
2. Strongly urge all counties to contact their legislative delegation to solicit their support in defeating this proposed legislation.
3. Direct that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the members of the North Carolina General Assembly representing Gates County with each Commissioner's heartfelt concern about the transfer of this and future State cost shifts to counties.
4. Direct that a copy of this resolution be sent to the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners and to the other North Carolina counties.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion for the Chairman to sign a letter requesting the Department of Transportation to replace a section of damaged pipe located at 405 Main Street, Gatesville. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew stated he has been contacted by citizens requesting to change the speed limit on the White Oak Road to 45 mph for the entire road. Commissioner Jordan suggested the Sheriff be consulted regarding this concern. Commissioner Askew stated he would research the concern and discuss it at the March meeting.

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, making a late appearance, explained Budget Amendments 45 and 47.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 45 and 47. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Edith Seiling, Gates County Historical Society, provided an update on the Society's activities. She presented the Board with copies of their 2010 Calendar Touring Historic Gates County and showed a copy of their book Just Down the Road.

Chairman Twine brought the meeting back to order after a brief recess.

Citizen Comments

Reba Green-Holley, Extension Director, introduced Ricky Wineberger, new 4-H Agent.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, thanked Commissioner Jordan on his concern of the rifle issue and Cal Bryant for the work he does in reporting in the Gates County Index. He stated the County needed stability and hopes the citizens support Commissioners Askew and Jernigan in their re-election. He feels Jack Owens would be an asset to the Board.

Sandra Nickens, Gatesville, wanted to know what the Board's plans were for the future, jobs are needed in the County.

Jack Owens, Gatesville, stated he has publicly announced he will run for the position of Commissioner of the First District.

Lycourcas Harrell wanted to know who and how the taxes were assessed in the County. He thought tax values fluctuated throughout the County.

Commissioner Jordan explained the re-valuation process and how the Board of Equalization and Review heard each case that was appealing the re-valuation.

Commissioner Comments

Commissioner Jordan stated the Albemarle Commission will be coming to the Board in the near future. The Commission is trying to create environmental jobs through grants for the Storm Water Drainage Program.

Commissioner Nickens stated he has no formal plans to seek re-election as Commissioner for the Gatesville District due to health concerns. He stated during his term all his decisions were made in the best interest of the citizens and the County.

Joe Greene, Eure, stated he would like to applaud Commissioner Nickens for all he has done for the county during his term.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(4)(6). Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition,

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to exit Closed Session. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to appoint Toby Chappell as Deputy Finance Officer, contingent it is in compliance with North Carolina general statutes, effective today, February 3, for a period of six (6) months. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan stated the leak in the magistrate's office needed to be repaired by a professional and requested Mr. Chappell address this concern.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.


